The Glucksman is currently offering an internship opportunity to work with the Curator of Education + Collections for a four week period on an **extensive documentation and digitisation project** for the University College Cork Art Collection. The internship provides an opportunity to work first-hand with modern and contemporary art, and gain an insight into collections management, art handling and documentation practice in accordance with the Museum Standards Programme of Ireland. Specific responsibilities will include preparing and handling artworks during transport and digitisation, assisting in photography of works for the collection database, and documentation of artworks that are being digitized.

The Collections Management Internship will require an interest in visual art and photography, and a commitment of 5 days a week for the period from **11 October – 5 November 2010**. The **Internship is unpaid** and based in the Lewis Glucksman Gallery, University College Cork. The intern will work as part of the Glucksman gallery team and report to the Curator of Education + Collections. The internship will be accredited in published materials relating to the digitisation of the collection.

The Collections Management internship is only available from **11 October – 5 November 2010** and the intern will be selected on the basis of:

- **Fluent oral and written English**
- **Demonstrable knowledge and interest in contemporary art**
