As a way of doing this, we have established a number of exhibition tours that look at different aspects of our programme as well as at the award-winning architecture of the Lewis Glucksman Gallery.

There are three different types of tours on offer. These are intended to provide your group with a range of approaches in looking at contemporary art and architecture:

1. **Exhibition Tours:** introduces your group to the current exhibition, using specific works to provide an understanding of relevant issues and ideas in visual arts today
2. **Architecture Tours:** demonstrates how the architectural design and engineering of the building facilitates practical, functional and environmental concerns
3. **Leaving Cert Tours:** uses the specifications of the National Curriculum Leaving Certificate to enhance students' understanding of relevant issues in contemporary art exhibitions
