These sessions are tailored for different age groups to introduce creative and collaborative activities. This season our focus is on children's rights and through the **See You, See Me** project schools will have the opportunity to develop rights-based awareness while creating artworks for public exhibition.

Primary School Junior Cycle (5-8 years)

Workshop 1: See You, See Me - Creativity and Play

Explore the right to play in this creative workshop that invites students to create imaginative artworks for public exhibition. This workshop will encourage participants to take inspiration from the illustrations in our **Viewpoints** exhibition before creating unique drawings and collages that celebrate the importance of play.

Workshop 2: See You, See Me - Family + Identity

This creative workshop invites participants to explore the right to and importance of family. The UN Convention on the Rights of the Child addresses the importance of family in the development of a child's identity. Taking Mary Murphy's illustration in the **Viewpoints** exhibition as our inspiration, students will create artworks that capture the unique nature of their own family.

Primary School Senior Cycle (8-12 years)

Workshop 1: See You, See Me – Education

How does education shape our personality and talents? And what would our lives be like without the support of school and other learning opportunities? These are the questions we will look to explore in this **See You, See Me** creative workshop. Under the guidance of our trained facilitator students will develop collaborative artworks for public exhibition.

Workshop 2: See You, See Me – Equality

Equality is fundamental to the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. This creative workshop invites students to explore the theme of equality through visuals and text. Working with a trained facilitator participants will create collaborative artworks that present messages of fairness and equality.
