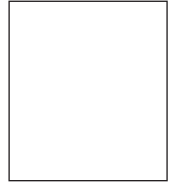

Citywide exhibition by young artists

In August 2019, 27 young asylum seekers, refugees and migrants explored their relationship to music through creative activities at the Glucksman in a *Creative Agency* project curated by **Tadhg Crowley**.
